Prepare for your ocean adventure:

- Lather up with mineral-based sunscreen. Wear additional sun protection, such as a hat and sunglasses.
- Fill a reusable water bottle if you'd like to stay hydrated during the walk. Step into your best walking shoes.
- Buckets or shell bags will be provided if you wish to collect treasures to take home!
- The bugs can be plenty, especially first thing in the morning. The best defense is long sleeves and pants. We'll have some bug lotion ready for you, too, if needed.
- **No parking available;** if you are not staying at the condominiums, please plan to park at Bowman's Beach and walk over.
